



Minutes: Call to Caucus 12-12-2019

2020/2021 Reorganizational Caucus

Meeting called to order by temporary chair David Reuther at 6:30 PM

Official time-keeping clock was recognized

David stated the purpose of the meeting: To elect Democrats to membership of the Culpeper County Democratic Committee.

Election of a permanent chair.

Motion by Peggy Kenney to nominate Michael McClary as permanent chair.

Motion to close nominations by Peggy Campbell. **Second** by Sandra Reaves-Yates

Mike was elected by a show of hands with no dissent.

Mike appointed Ed Dunphy as caucus secretary.

Mike called the Credentials Committee (Donna DeAngelis, Peggy Kenney and Cat Reuther) to report the number of registered voters present who have filled out the Caucus Participation Form.

Donna stated the number was 37 qualified participants.

The tally of the committee was approved by voice vote.

Mike moved for the adoption of the rules for the caucus. No amendments were offered, and the rules were adopted without objection.

Ed Dunphy read the names of 65 members who had turned in their membership applications. Mike asked if there were any objections to the members, hearing none he called for a voice vote. The new members were approved without objection.

Mike asked that we forgo the 10-minute adjournment. As there was no objection from those in attendance we moved directly into the election of officers.

The nominations for the CCDC Executive Committee were presented and there were no contested offices. The assembled group elected the Executive Committee by voice acclamation with no dissent.
